

Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Conflict Mineral Policy :

1. Our company does not procure any conflict minerals extracted from the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or its surrounding countries and regions that are associated with armed conflict, illegal mining, or poor working conditions.
2. Suppliers shall refrain from using conflict minerals originating from conflict-affected and high-risk areas (CAHRAs). They are required to provide a written declaration committing that the minerals used comply with the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals and are not sourced through illegal smuggling or other unlawful means.
3. Suppliers are required to communicate and implement the above requirements to their upstream suppliers to ensure that the entire supply chain complies with applicable conflict minerals regulations.
